Water availability is scarce in parts of Johnson County. It is recommended that you verify a sufficient water source prior to construction.

Drainage to a county legal drain requires Drainage Board approval.

Site Protection - Cutting, filling, compaction or disturbing the septic field site may cause the septic permit to be revoked. The septic field area must be fenced or roped off to protect the site.

Soil Wetness – Septic systems may not be installed in wet soil conditions. Installation of the absorption field in wet soil may cause damage to the soil structure.

Any tank may float. Anti-buoyancy measures per the tank manufacturer are always recommended.

A Bedroom is defined as any room that could be occupied for sleeping, having seventy (70) square feet or more, at least one (1) operable window or exterior door & for new construction, a closet.
