ORDINANCE NO. 2024-13 An Ordinance for the Appropriations of Ordinance Violation Fine Fund (#4201)

WHEREAS, the Johnson County Ordinance Violation Fine Fund (#4201) was created by the Johnson County Auditor for the collection of ordinance fines after the Johnson County Commissioners approved Ordinance 82-7 creating the Johnson County Animal Control Department and establishing the Johnson County Animal Control Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, since August of 2022, the Johnson County Attorneys have taken over prosecution of all Animal Control Ordinance Violations, as authorized under Indiana Code §34-28-5, from the Johnson County Prosecutor's Office and as a result controls the appropriations from fund #4201; and

WHEREAS, the Johnson County Attorneys desire to appropriate fund #4201 as legally appropriate under Indiana Code § 33-37-8-6; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

The Johnson County Attorneys, through the Board of Commissioners, shall be allowed, after proper appropriation by the Johnson County Council to expend monies deposited into the Johnson County Ordinance Violation Fine Fund (#4201) as legally appropriate per Indiana Code § 33-37-8-6.
