

COMMISSIONERS' REGULAR MEETING – MONDAY, AUGUST 11, 2025

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Brian Baird at 10:00 a.m. Kevin Walls and Ron West were present.

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. West gave the Invocation and Mr. Baird led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment – (limited to agenda topics and 5 minutes per person)

There were no public comments.

Opening of Sealed Bids for Johnson County Juvenile Detention Entrance Reconstruction Project

Tiffany Costley, County Attorney, read the following bids out loud:

DeWees Construction, Inc. – Bargersville, IN	\$346,378.00
White Oak Commercial Group – Indianapolis, IN	\$293,318.00
Duke Commercial – Bargersville, IN	\$310,000.00

Mr. Walls made a motion to give the bids to Mr. Baird and Wes Harrison, Project Manager, to review and be awarded at their next meeting. Mr. West seconded the motion which carried unanimously. Mr. Walls also made a statement “This accident was caused by a very bad person in our community that all of the taxpayers will have to pay for”.

Damon Cox, Assistant Director, was present for approval of Memorandum of Understanding with Firefly Children & Family Alliance for Family Resource and Educational Support Services. Mr. West stated that he still had questions about Firefly and their finances. Mr. Cox stated that the money that they are receiving is given to Firefly by the State of Indiana. Firefly is a placeholder for the monies that are given. The State cut the funding to \$140,000 dollars, which is the reason for the reduction in funding.

Michele Hansard, Director, was present to discuss the Zoning Ordinance 2025-Z-3.

Daniel Johnston, Highway Engineer, was present for approval and execution of Indiana Sign & Barricade Order #1 for the 2024 Pavement Marking Project. Mr. Johnston stated they added three road segments to the project so they can be striped. They coordinated with the town of Bargersville and will get reimbursed for the town's segment on CR 144. Mr. Johnston also stated that they had to do some extra asphalt and paving due to poor subgrade soils on one of the segments.

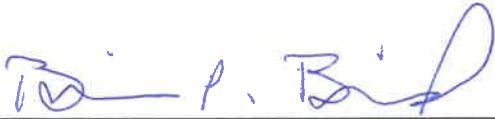
